

CAMPING AND TRAILER PARKING RULES AND REGULATIONS

In addition to Public Health and State Campground rules, the following rules must be observed:

- 1) Camping sites will be reserved on a first come, first served basis. Sites will be assigned by Cheboygan County Fair and Campground Superintendent.
- 2) Camping fee will be \$100 (includes electricity) for the week of Fair or \$15 per night, these fees DO NOT INCLUDE gate entry fee. AIR CONDITIONING USE IS NOT ALLOWED. Any camping other than Fair week will be \$15 per night.
- 3) Camping fee must be submitted with reservation. Starting in January 2015, payment in full is required with your reservation.
- 4) All trailers must be self-contained, gopher holes will not be allowed, only ONE (1) camper per site.
- 5) Picnic table rental is \$20 for the week of fair, while availability lasts.
- 6) Camping permit must be displayed on camper where it is visible to all.
- 7) There will be curfew hours enforced – 12:00 midnight to 6:00 a.m. This means that no campsite will have disturbance or excessive noise during curfew hours.
- 8) Campsites must be chaperoned by parent or registered guardian 18 years of age or over (with written permission on file in the fair office).
- 9) Cheboygan County Fair or MSUE assumes no responsibility for any damage or loss of trailers or contents while on the Fairgrounds.
- 10) Campers may arrive during normal business hours only (8 a.m.-4:30 p.m.) After hours parking by appointment. Campers left in unauthorized spots will be moved at owner's expense.
- 11) All exhibitors staying overnight at the fairgrounds **must be under the DIRECT supervision of a parent or responsible guardian. Written permission from a parent or legal guardian must be submitted to the designated camping superintendent if exhibitor is staying with another non-parent, non-legal guardian adult.**
- 12) All trailers in camping area must be under the responsibility of a parent or registered guardian, 18 years of age or over AT ALL TIMES.
- 13) Any camper observed consuming alcohol or in possession of illegal drugs will be asked to remove their camper from the Fairgrounds immediately. Proper authorities will be notified.
- 14) By signing the camping permit application, it is agreed to adhere to all rules and regulations. This is signed permission that designated camping superintendents and Cheboygan County Fair, can and will, have permission to inspect any campsite where there is a disturbance, excessive noise or suspected infraction of camping rules.
- 15) These guidelines were adopted and will be enforced by both the Cheboygan County Fair and MSUE.
- 16) **NO** horse trailer(s) parking between drive and the horse barn and/or side row of trailers and the horse barn or at the ends of the horse barn; **these areas are for loading and unloading only.** Any horse trailer not parked in designated areas, and/or drawing electrical, and/or water from the barn, will be charged a camping fee.
- 17) Do to liability concerns, only properly licensed and insured motor vehicles are allowed in the campground area. Personal 4 wheelers, golf carts and motorized utility vehicles, etc are forbidden without the express written consent of the Fair Manager.
- 18) **Please put all garbage in dumpsters.**
